## **BULWAGGA BAY RV PARK RULES**

- 1. Both parties hereby recognize that it is a privilege, not a right to camp at Bulwagga Bay RV Park. Both parties hereby agree to waive any and all lawful process otherwise required by law to remove a camper in violation or perceived violation of this agreement or of any camp or beach rules otherwise posted or of which camper is otherwise aware.
- 2. No one under the age of 18 is allowed to camp unless accompanied by an adult.
- 3. The registered camper assumes all responsibility for all guests. All campers must check in and register with the managers. Payment is due in full upon arrival. Office hours are 9:00AM 5:00PM, except on the three major holidays: Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day. Friday and Saturday the office hours are 9:00AM 7:00PM. Check out time is 11:00AM.
- 4. Quiet time is 10:00PM to 8:00AM. (The general rule is that the noise level from your camp site should not be any louder than a normal speaking voice outside the perimeter of your site). For safety reasons, there is no bike riding after dark.
- 5. The gate will be closed at 10:00PM on Friday and Saturday. On all other days, the gate will be closed at 9:00PM. When the gate is closed, only registered campers will be allowed in. All unregistered campers, visitors, and guests must leave the premises before 10:00PM.
- 6. Dogs are allowed on premises only under the following circumstances:
  - A. All Dogs on premises must be registered with Campground Manager prior to entering the park. Any camper wishing to have a dog at their site must first provide to the Campground Manager satisfactory proof of the dog's registration and rabies vaccination. Dogs must be leashed at all times. No leash shall exceed 10 feet in length. All dog owners must clean up after their pets by removing and properly disposing of any dog waste. Dogs may not be left unattended at any time. No site may have more than 2 dogs. Persistent barking will not be tolerated and will result in removing the dog from the premises.
  - B. The Town of Moriah reserves the right to refuse any dog on the premises for any reason. The Town of Moriah reserves the right to compel any dog removed from the premises for any reason without use of any further lawful process, regardless of whether or not such dog has been properly registered with its owner and the site.

- 7. Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.
- 8. The maximum number of people allowed on a site is (at the discretion of the Managers) 6; 2 adults, 4 children under the age of 18. (ALL OVERNITE VISITORS "OVER THE AGE OF 18" MUST REGISTER AND PAY \$15.00 PER NIGHT).
- 9. One canopy per site is allowed. No canopy may block, prohibit, or obstruct in any way the view of the lake. If sides are on the canopy, they must be made of a mesh type material, the material must be transparent, and may not block the view of other campers.
- 10. Any campers or visitor who is disorderly or disruptive and violates any of the conditions of this agreement must leave the premises immediately upon the request by the Park Manager.
