TOWN OF MORIAH

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 2010

A local law regarding dog licensing and procurement in the Town of Moriah.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Moriah.

SECTION 1. Purpose. Formerly the State of New York collected dog licensing fees. The purpose of this Town of Moriah Law is to allow the Town of Moriah to retain the licensing fees.

SECTION 2. Licensing Fees. The fee for spayed and neutered dogs is \$5.00. The fee for dogs not spayed and not neutered is \$13.00.

SECTION 3. Authority. This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Section 124 of Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.

SECTION 4. Seizure, Impoundment, Redemption and Adoption

(a) Any dog found in violation of the provisions of Section 5 of this local law may be seized pursuant to the provision of Section 118 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.

- (b) Every dog seized shall be property cared for, sheltered, fed and watered for the redemption periods set forth in Section 118 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.
- (c) Seized dogs may be redeemed by producing proof of licensing and identification pursuant to the provisions of Article 7 of the Agriculture and Markets Law and by paying the impoundment fees set forth in Section 118 of said Article.
- (d) If the owner of any unredeemed dog is known, such owner shall be required to pay the impoundment fees set forth in subdivision © of this section whether or not such owner chooses to redeem his or her dog.
- (e) Any dog unredeemed at the expiration of the appropriate redemption period, shall be made available for adoption or euthanized pursuant to the provisions of Section 118 of the Agriculture and Markets Law.

SECTION 5.

Separability. Each separate provision of this ordinance shall be deemed independent of all other provision herein, and if any provisions

shall be deemed or declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall remain valid and enforceable.

SECTION 6.

Effective Date. This local law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State.


