LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE CONDUCT OF GAMES OF CHANCE IN THE TOWN OF MORIAH

- BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Moriah as follows:
- \$1. $\underline{\textbf{TITLE}}\colon$ This local law shall be known as the Games of Chance Law of the Town of Moriah.
- §2. <u>DEFINITIONS</u>: "<u>Authorized Organization</u>" shall mean an authorized organization as defined in ¶4 of §186 of the General Municipal Law. "<u>Games of Chance</u>" shall mean a game of chance as defined in ¶3 of §186 of the General Municipal Law.
- §3. GAMES OF CHANCE AUTHORIZED. Authorized organizations, may upon obtaining a license from the Town Clerk of the Town of Moriah, conduct games of chance within the town of Moriah, as provided in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law and as provided further in this local law. Such games of chance shall be conducted in accordance with the laws of the State of New York and with the rules and regulations adopted by the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and pursuant to this local law.
- \$4. **RESTRICTIONS.** The conduct of games of chance shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by \$189 of the General Municipal Law.
- §5. <u>SUNDAY GAMES</u>. Games of Chance may be conducted on Sunday, pursuant to this local law. However, no Games of Chance shall be conducted on Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or New Year's Eve.
- §6. ENFORCEMENT. The Essex County Sheriff's Department shall exercise control over and supervision of all games of chance conducted under duly authorized license. The Chief of Police shall have all those powers and duties set forth in and for the enforcement of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.
