

The Town of Moriah Town Board held a Public Hearing on Friday, December 27, 2019 at 9:45am on the Lamos Lane Sewer Main Replacement CDBG Project at the Town of Moriah Town Hall, 38 Park Place, Port Henry, New York.

Supervisor Scozzafava called the meeting to order at 9:45am.

He then read the legal notice calling for the Public Hearing. The Town Clerk stated there were no written comments from the public.

The Supervisor stated we had our written performance review on this project; we were not aware that we had to hold another public hearing once we reached 60% of funding; that is why we are having this hearing. The Supervisor stated this project has been closed for two (2) years. In the future we will have to have a performance hearing for any CDBG project once 60% of the funding has been spent.

The Supervisor stated that the Village of Port Henry did have a performance hearing on the Rice Street Project. Councilman Brassard stated he believed there was an audit on that project also. The Supervisor stated you have to spend \$750,000 in a fiscal year. Councilman Brassard asked who determines the percentage and the Supervisor stated we can do that right here. The Supervisor stated that we came in under budget on the Lamos Lane Project and Manfred Construction did a great job. They were low bidder and there was @ \$46,000 leftover in the project. Councilman Salerno asked if we could use leftover money for Forge Hollow and the Supervisor stated no. The money has to be used for what it is ear marked for. Councilman Salerno asked if we end up being under budget in the water and sewer project in Port Henry could we use that for something else and the Supervisor said no.
