Supervisor Scozzafava called the Public Hearing to order at 5:30pm by saluting the flag.

He then read the legal notice calling for the Public Hearing.

The Town Clerk stated there were no written comments from the public.

The Supervisor gave a brief history on the Tarbell Hill Pump Station. It was installed in 1988. Parts need replacing and a generator will be installed. This is needed in case of a power outage or a catastrophic event. This was a grant that the Town received. We have not received one cent from New York State as of today. The Town will borrow the \$300,000 so we won't clean out the fund balance. Hoping to pay it off next year.

Councilman Anderson asked if this was for Sewer District #1 residents only that have to pay it back and the Supervisor said yes; however, there will be no impact on the sewer rate.
