

The Town of Moriah Town Board held a Public Hearing on CDBG Public Infrastructure Grant and CDBG Public Facilities Grant on Thursday, July 11, 2019 at 5:45pm at the Town of Moriah Court House, 42 Park Place, Port Henry, New York.

Supervisor Scozzafava opened the meeting at 5:45pm by saluting the flag.

He then read the legal notices for the Public Hearings. He stated that the first CDBG application is for \$750,000 for infrastructure for First and Second Streets in Port Henry for Water and Sewer. Councilman Brassard asked if the income surveys for last year are still good and Chip Perry said yes. Mr. Perry stated that the announcement date should be in September.

The Supervisor stated that the 2<sup>nd</sup> CDBG application is for \$300,000 and this one is for improvements at the Town Hall; such as handicap accessibility.

The Supervisor asked if there were any questions or concerns. Councilman Anderson asked if we would be fined if the Town Hall was not in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Supervisor said no, he said they know we are making an effort to comply. The Supervisor stated that the Town Clerk's office is very good at trying to accommodate everyone, they will go out to vehicles if necessary.
