Enlisted, 26 years old, on 18 Aug 1864 at Plattsburg, NY as a Private,

Enlisted, 38 years old, on 23 Aug 1864 at Plattsburg, NY as Private,
Battery L, 1st NY Light Artillery. On 1 Jan 1865 transferred to Battery G.
Mustered Out on 19 Jun 1865 at Elmira, NY.

Westcott, Erastus S. (a.k.a. Wescott) died 12 Feb 1867 AE 23 Co C, 5th NY Cav
20 years old. Enlisted 12/11/1863 Plattsburg, NY as a Private.
On 12/11/1863 he mustered into "C" Co. NY 5th Cavalry
Mustered Out on 5/27/1865 at New York, NY

War of 1812, (Sherman Cem):

Sherman, Amos D. Died 3 February 1887, Aged 91
"A Private in Captain Thomas Winslow's Company, NY Militia, War of 1812".
