NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners, a special election of the qualified voters of the Port Henry Fire District #3 in Moriah, New York, Essex County will be held at the Port Henry Fire Department's Firehouse located at 14 Church Street, Port Henry, New York, 12974 on the 2nd day of June, 2026, between the hours of 12 p.m. and 9 pm. to vote on whether to approve the following one resolutions adopted by such Board of Fire Commissioners:

RESOLUTION NO. 1

RESOLUTION FOR DEMOLITION OF BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF NEW BUILDING

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS OF THE PORT HENRY FIRE DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF MORIAH, ESSEX COUNTY, NEW YORK (THE "DISTRICT"), AUTHORIZING THE DEMOLITION OF A BUILDING AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CLASS A BUILDING, THE MAXIMUM COST OF WHICH IS ANTICIPATED TO BE \$4,900,000; APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT THEREFORE; AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCING BY ISSUANCE OF A SERIAL BOND OR STATUTORY INSTALLMENT BOND FOR UP TO THIRTY (30) YEARS FOR THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT ISSUED BY BOND OF \$1,600,000 PRINCIPAL, AND TO ISSUE BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ABOVE, FOR UP TO FIVE (5) CONSECUTIVE YEARS, AND TO USE GRANT FUNDS UP TO \$3,280,841 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE PROJECT.

All persons registered to vote in the district and residing in the fire district for at least thirty (30) days prior to the day of the vote (registered by May 30, 2026) may vote in such special election.

Pursuant to Local Finance Law Section 80, the validity of such bonds or notes or any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds may be contested only if such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the fire district is not authorized to expend money; or if the provisions of law which should be complied with as of this date are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication; or such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution.
