LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2008

TITLE: A Local Law, to provide for the maximum of income eligibility limitation from real property tax exemption for Senior Citizens from \$22,000.00 to \$25,000.00.

BE IN ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Moriah, Essex County as follows:

This local law shall be entitled: "A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE TOWN OF MORIAH TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAXIMUM OF INCOME ELIGIBILITY LIMITATION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS, FROM \$22,000.00 to \$25,000.00.

SECTION 2. Subject Local Law proposing to increase the maximum amount of chargeable income that an eligible person (or persons) 65 years of age or older, (so-called "Senior Citizens"), may be receiving above which they may not be eligible for 50% Assessed Valuation Exemption on Eligible owned real property all pursuant to the Real Property Tax Law Section 467.

**SECTION 3.** This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its due filing and recording, as legal prescribed.
