LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 2008

TITLE: A Local Law, to provide for the maximum of income eligibility limitation from real property tax exemption for Senior Citizens from \$22,000.00 to \$25,000.00.

BE IN ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Moriah, Essex County as follows:

SECTION 1. This local law shall be entitled: "A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR THE TOWN OF MORIAH TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAXIMUM OF INCOME ELIGIBILITY LIMITATION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR SENIOR CITIZENS, FROM \$22,000.00 to \$25,000.00.

SECTION 2. Subject Local Law proposing to increase the maximum amount of chargeable income that an eligible person (or persons) 65 years of age or older, (so-called "Senior Citizens"), may be receiving above which they may not be eligible for 50% Assessed Valuation Exemption on Eligible owned real property all pursuant to the Real Property Tax Law Section 467.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its due filing and recording, as legal prescribed.

This Resolution was duly ADOPTED.


